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**TIME SENSITIVE: Federal Health Insurance Marketplace for 2021 Coverage
Open Enrollment November 1 through December 15, 2020**

Moraine Township is offering **REMOTE** assistance to residents wishing to enroll for health insurance on the Federal Marketplace under the Affordable Care Act. Residents who need to obtain 2021 health insurance on the Federal Marketplace have only 45 days to enroll: November 1, 2020 through December 15, 2020.

Trained and Certified counselors are available to work remotely one-on-one with residents to help them understand their options, balance their medical needs and budgets, compare coverage and costs, and ensure that enrollees receive the premium subsidies and cost-sharing reductions they may be income-qualified to receive.

Residents who are currently enrolled in health insurance plans through the Marketplace can re-enroll in their existing plan for another year or select a new plan. A Counselor will help enrollees learn about changes that may have taken place in their existing plan, or review details and compare costs of alternative plans.

“With many people currently unemployed due to the COVID crisis, we are concerned that residents who are not aware of this short window of time to obtain 2021 coverage will miss out for the whole year if they are not enrolled by December 15,” notes 8-year Certified Application Counselor volunteer Barbara Altman.
